

MUST-HAVE PPE GEAR

AT EVERY WORK SITE



1. HEAD PROTECTION

Worn when workers may be exposed to overhead dangers like falling objects - OSHA Requirement 1910.135(a)(1)

- ☐ Hard Hat Type 1 & 2: Cap, Full Brim, and Climbing (Chin Strap) styles available

2. EYE PROTECTION



Worn when flying debris or hazardous materials may be present.

- ☐ Safety Glasses – Goggles, Shields, Foam-lined options

3. HI-VIZ SAFETY VEST

Worn when increased visibility is needed around the worksite.

- ☐ Hi-viz shirts - Jackets are alternatives
- ☐ Replace when dirty or ripped/worn
- ☐ Orange/Lime based on work/location (i.e: X-back orange for railroad)
- ☐ Two-tone & lighted options available for increased visibility

4. HEARING PROTECTION



Worn when noise exposure is at or above 85 decibels averaged over 8 working hours according to OSHA.

- ☐ Earmuffs - over the head or clip in.
- ☐ Earplugs - corded, uncorded, and plug styles available.



5. HAND PROTECTION

Worn when workers may be exposed to cutting tools or hazardous materials.

- ☐ Gloves – General-purpose; Cut, Puncture, and Abrasive Resistant options

6. FOOTWEAR



Always worn by workers when present at the worksite.

- ☐ Work Boots - Safety Toe (Steel and Composite), Waterproof, Overshoes
